- Reorganized Staff and developed a healthy and energized work environment based on relational investment, gift realization, and fun
- Developed financial strategies that moved the financial situation from seeking a line of credit for monthly responsibilities to 400k in working capital along with new next step strategies for long term financial health

- Partnered with Local, City, and Church leadership to communicate and serve during the Covid 19 crisis
